

GDPR INFORMATION CLAUSE FOR PATIENTS

Prywatne Centrum Medyczne "Medyk-Centrum"

English translation of the Polish original („Klauzula RODO dla pacjentów”). In the event of any discrepancy between the two language versions, the Polish version shall prevail.

Pursuant to Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation of 27 April 2016 (OJ EU L 119, 4.5.2016) – GDPR, we inform that:

1. The controller of your personal data is
Prywatne Centrum Medyczne „Medyk-Centrum” Jan Bińczyk, Al. Wolności 34, 42-200 Częstochowa
2. You may contact the Data Protection Officer by email at iod@netbel.pl or in writing at the Controller's registered address.
3. Your personal data will be processed on the basis of:
 - Article 6(1)(c) GDPR, the Act on Patients' Rights and the Patients' Rights Ombudsman (Journal of Laws 2009, No. 52, item 417, as amended), and the Regulation of the Minister of Health of 9 November 2015 on the types, scope and templates of medical documentation and the manner of its processing (Journal of Laws 2015, item 2069, as amended) – for the purpose of providing medical services and maintaining medical records.
 - Article 9(2)(h) GDPR – as processing of information on health status in connection with the provision of medical services.
 - Article 6(1)(f) GDPR – as part of the legitimate interest consisting of the establishment and defense of legal claims.
4. The recipients of your personal data will be solely entities authorized to obtain personal data under legal provisions, as well as entities providing IT services in the scope of software and hardware maintenance for the Controller, other medical entities participating in the treatment process, and persons authorized by patients.
5. Your personal data will be stored for a period of 20 years, in accordance with applicable legal acts.
6. You have the right to request from the Controller access to your personal data, rectification thereof, and
 - to the extent this does not contradict applicable law - the right to erasure, restriction of processing, and to object to processing.
7. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (the President of the Personal Data Protection Office) if you consider that your personal data are being processed in violation of the law.
8. Providing personal data for the purpose of delivering medical services and maintaining medical documentation is mandatory under legal provisions.
